

ROHS3 CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

JTC Micro Electronics NV declares that all (sub)assemblies manufactured and soldered under the LF-program, are ROHS complaint according to the definitions and restrictions given by the European Parlement, Directive 2015/863/EU, known as ROHS3, on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

All ROHS compliant (sub)assemblies do not exceed the maximum limit for the following 6 designated substances:

- Lead (PB)	<1000 ppm
- Mercury (HG)	<1000 ppm
- Cadmium (CD)	<100 ppm
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI)	< 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)	< 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)	< 1000 ppm
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	< 1000 ppm
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	< 1000 ppm
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	< 1000 ppm
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	< 1000 ppm

Products containing the substances listed above in concentrations below the MCV are understood to be in compliance with directive 2015/863/EU of the European Parliament and the Council of 4 June 2015 on the restriction on the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronics equipment (RoHS Directive) in accordance with the definitions set fourth in the directives.
